Chemicals of Emerging Concern (CEC) ad hoc Committee Charter

CHARTER: Our simple charge for this ad hoc committee is to understand, monitor, and respond to the science and policy that may develop into regulatory/legislative activity related to the rapidly growing forum on compounds of emerging concern.

CHAIR: Dan Curry, Director of Strategic Project Development, TRC

AUTHORITY/RESPONSIBILITIES: The ad hoc committee will fall under the oversight of the Science & Technology / Government Affairs (STGA) joint committees. While the STGA may request information or deliverables from time to time, the CEC is requested to proactively determine what is happening in North Carolina that may affect manufactures and formulate response, as necessary. The CEC will become a regular STGA agenda item for updates and status reports.

PARTICIPATION: The CEC has members who are subject matter experts, policy watchers and industrial practitioners to address a variety of issue that may develop. Meetings will ideally be hosted live/inperson especially when guests are invited to participate, but realizing the busy nature of important people, a Zoom link will be available for each meeting.

SCHEDULE: For the foreseeable future, CEC committee should plan to routinely schedule meetings for 10:00 AM on the third Thursday of each month to coincide with the STGA meetings that occur monthly at 1:00 PM.
